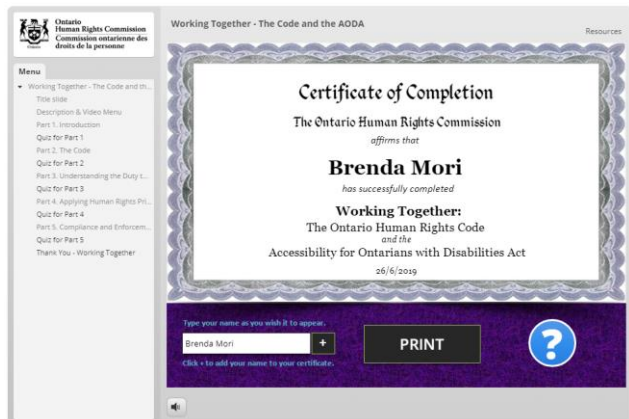


3. Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA):
