POSITION: Unit 4 Co-Lead (Neurological Physical Therapy): Casual Academic Contract

ALLOCATION: 270 hours

DEPARTMENT: Physical Therapy, University of Toronto

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist with curriculum planning support the development of curriculum material including but not exclusive to: the unit schedule; annual review of content; coordinating and liaising with faculty, community partners, and guest speakers
- Review and deliver clinical skills labs (labs to be determined)
- > Participate in educational activities (e.g., lectures, small groups as appropriate)
- Support teaching assistants, lab instructors, practical exam examiners, and small group facilitators
- Writing and marking of written tests and the practical exam
- > Support the management of the unit website
- Support the Academic Lead on the the day-to-day activities within the unit, including student issues as they arise
- Foster collaborative relationships within the Department, with clinical faculties and other departments at U of T, as well as beyond
